



Prep Installer Job Description

General Purpose

Responsible for successfully prepping for Architectural Fusions installations on a variety of substrates and in a variety of applications.

Job Responsibilities

- Receive and read installation instructions and details from Surfacequest Solutions Operations Team electronically that could include blueprints and drawings.
- Use your vehicle to pick up work materials and supplies from the Surfacequest Solutions warehouse in Edina, MN.
- Travel to local and state project sites as needed.
 - Travel to outside of Minnesota project sites as needed.
- Set up work area on the jobsite.
- Inspect and prepare the substrate to receive Architectural Fusions which could include:
 - Filling in with Bondo
 - Sanding/painting
 - Sealing
 - Cleaning with denatured alcohol
 - Cleaning and maintaining the substrate
- Clean up work area when work is complete.
- Return, unload and store materials and supplies in warehouse; clean and maintain storage areas.
- Communicate with other employees and customers in a calm and professional manner.

Experience and Expertise Required

- Able to work early mornings (late evenings, and weekends on occasion).
- Attention to detail, cleanliness and strong work ethic.
- Ability to work with and collaborate with Certified Installers and co-workers, other subcontractors and clients in the field.
- Desire to learn the skill sets required to become a Certified Fusion Installer.
- Valid Driver's License.
- Ability to lift/handle/carry equipment, material and supplies in the range of 5 – 65 pounds.
- Ability to work under pressure to output high volume, high quality work.
- Be able to safely work on tall walls using a lift or ladder.
- Be able to speak, read, and write in English.
- Be able to travel, as needed.
